

Saskatchewan Shuffleboard Association Builder's Award Nomination

So that it would not be commonplace, this award should honor the highest integrity and dedication to promotion of the game. In order to have a measure to determine the worthiness as a builder, each nomination must have some standard to meet or a percentage of criteria established by a panel of judges (current Board of Directors). The reasoning here is that it would be insufficient to have a nomination without reasons and the nomination would have to be supported by others (typically the panel but could be other members past and/or present).

The person nominating an individual for the award would have to present reasoning based on the criteria in order for the panel to make an informed choice. Individuals from the past may not have been active for ten to twenty years and may not be known by present players.

Nominations for the current year (season) must be submitted before Dec. 31. The SSA can accept them at any time during the year. A nomination will receive consideration only after it has met minimum criteria of acceptance and will be registered in a log and filed. All eligible nominations will be considered each time the Builder's Award is to be presented.

Numeric factors are used to aide the panel. Making a contribution to the well being of league play and increasing the number of people playing should have much importance. Each one of the factors is weighted so that some are worth additional merit.

Minimum Acceptable Standard:

Total numeric value available: 150 points

Minimum for acceptance (50%): 75 points

In each one of the categories, it would be expected that an individual would have been involved numerous times (total number not relevant but well noted over a period of years – at least twice for the higher value factors and 5 or more for the lesser factors, should be the norm).

Typically the award will be presented every two years (at the discretion of the panel). The panel will select a minimum of two eligible nominations from the list and shall invite the nominator of each one to attend the meeting in support of their nominee.

Nominations of Bars, Pubs, Clubs or Organizations may be submitted and will be considered on the merits of the reasons given for nomination and not by the above criteria.
